I am directed to forward herewith the application

to state that this Government have no objection to accord  
affiliation to it subject to the fulfillment of the following  
conditions:-

1. The State Government reserves the right to withdraw the  
above certificate at any time, if the management fails  
to comply with the instructions of the State Government  
such as illegal removal of teachers, non-payment of  
salaries to the teaching and non-teaching staff as per  
the approved scales etc.
2. Admissions should be made with the bonafide date of  
birth certificate.
3. All the untrained teachers should be replaced by  
trained teachers.
4. The management should collect the tuition fee and  
special fee etc., as prescribed by Government from  
time to time.
5. The strength in classes should be as per rules in force.
6. The management should follow the state syllabus for  
classes from I to V.
7. The school should follow the three language formula.
8. The District Educational Officer or his nominee should  
be invited when the management makes recruitment of  
candidates of various categories of posts.


